The Hierarchy of Love and Light

Most people don't think that such a thing as a hierarchy exists. When you mention hierarchy to them they react in a negative and emotional way. Not realising that all life is hierarchical in its setup. If they were to look at the way their physical body is constituted they will see that there are a lot of energies that are bound together as atoms, these atoms are put together to produce molecules, the molecules of which there are trillions, are then combined to produce larger molecules such as lymph or protein molecules, or macromolecules. These macromolecules then combine to create organelles, myriads of organelles become cells then these cells combined with other cells produce parts of larger organs such as the kidney or liver. All these larger organs then have their own particular functions as a part of the body that are coordinated via a myriad of systems in the body including the heart brain and nervous system. This combines to create a macro synergistic energy system that we call a human being. This is all hierarchically set up. One part of the brain is dedicated to keeping the heart functioning which keeps you alive, another part is dedicated to regulating your body temperature, another part is connected with your breathing and the list goes on. There is a massive sympathetic system regulating your body that you are totally unaware of. The other part of your body is the thinking side of your system. This will tell you what type of food that you would like to eat or what you would like to do or how you would like to act. This is the hierarchical set up in the human body.

Hierarchy is God's plan for all the kingdoms of nature. For the entire system of Being. If you look at the planet as a whole you will see the same thing. You'll see a mineral kingdom, and in this mineral kingdom there are billions upon billions upon billions of atoms all bound together and set as molecules, compounds and chemicals. Upon that there are billions of different types of plants in the plant kingdom. Within the plant kingdom we have very primitive plants such as the fungi and the algae, and then you get ferns and then we go on to the flowering plants and a huge trees that seem to be the head of the hierarchy of plants. Then we get the next evolution in nature, as science has postulated as you know, they say we have come from single cell entities and eventually in the waters came such things as fish which eventually crawled out of the water with legs which produced amphibians which then produced animals that started to conquer the land. From that evolved the reptiles and they evolved into mammals and then we get the birds and this whole hierarchical system on the terrestrial biosphere of this earth. Of course, the top of the pinnacle of life is human beings who can control all of nature, they are numerically the smallest number of animals or entities on this planet. They are at the very top of the hierarchy, the food chain on this planet. Underneath them are an increasingly larger number of entities until you get to, say, the insects where there are trillions upon trillions of flies, for instance on just one part of this planet. This is compared to the mere millions of human beings.

So when you look at the entire planet you see all of life is organised according to hierarchical systems. And when you look at the planet within itself you see that it is just one planet within a solar system of many planets, and all the stars are organised according to constellations and then the constellations interrelate as a small part of a spiral arm of a galaxy, and then the galaxy is part of a super galaxy and super galactic clusters move onwards in time and space as part of the of the universe. All of this once again, is Hierarchically instigated from one galaxy composed of billions of suns, and the billions of suns are all organised and obey simple laws of motion and evolution, and the suns have trillions and trillions of planets and the planets have possible life forms such as we are on this earth. This could be from human forms down to subhuman species. We also have the Devic and the Angelic kingdom and the way they are organised. It is impossible to think of life, it is impossible to think of evolution, it is impossible to think of the universe without thinking of Hierarchy. Yet most human beings seem to think that no such thing exists.

When we are talking about the Hierarchy of Light and Love, what we are talking about is the way that human beings throughout the eons of evolution developed consciousness and developed into Enlightened Beings. Beings evolve on the path of Love and Light. And when they become highly sophisticated beings through myriads of incarnations and they become a Jesus or a Buddha or all of these other great sages and saints that have worked for humanity trying to help all the kingdoms of nature. When these entities die they don't simply disappear into a vacuum or empty space or sit in front of God and sing with harps, "*Holy Holy Holy*". That would be tantamount to a hell state! Especially if somebody has spent all of there lives just helping human beings or all the kingdoms of nature. These Beings know that to help properly they must band together, working together with heart and hand. They must work together with the collective mind and the collective consciousness -- a community of consciousness. This unified collective helping of humanity whether they are in incarnation or out of incarnation, we call the Hierarchy of Light and Love. They are working together with a unified consciousness, with one heart to help humanity and all the kingdoms of nature to evolve.

These beings are the ones that have helped bring about all of the world's religions -- Buddhism, Christianity, the Judaic religion, the primitive religions and so forth. They have brought about the civilisations, they have seen the rise and deaths of such civilisations as the Greek, or the Roman, the Mayan, the Aztec, the Oceanic civilisations, the Indians. Whatever culture you see flowering, there you have the hand of these Enlightened Beings. They incarnate into humanity and they become the great teachers and the great leaders of those societies, if they are working for the betterment of human beings. All members of Hierarchy have incarnated many, many times to help human beings and they don't have a favouritism for a specific religion or culture, because just as there are many cells in the body and many organs in the body, when you look from a higher plane of

perception at all the religions of the world and all of the different types of cultural situations and different types of races of Beings and the different types of governments that we have, then what we are really looking at cumulatively speaking is the body of a human being with different organs, different parts of a body, different chakras. So Hierarchy incarnate into the various organs of this collective Being that we call Humanity. If you look at it closely enough you could give humanity a gender, but at this stage I won't go into it.

What I am trying to point out is that the Hierarchy at any particular point in time are working at, for instance, the stimulation of the heart of humanity, the heart of this great entity that is called human. That heart may be a particular civilisation on this earth in a specific time zone. The heart of humanity for instance, has been for thousands of years the Egyptian civilisation. And the Egyptian civilisation has held the wisdom religion of all time for thousands upon thousands of years there. Even before the great flood. According to modern day scientists the great Sphinx was built before the great flood well over 10,000 years ago because the weather patterning on the Sphinx can only be produced by very, very heavy rains. This is a geologically proven fact by the best geologists today. When was the last time that Egypt had major rains in this desert area? Well over 6 to 9000 BC. What civilisation existed then? According to orthodox paleontologists and archaeologists -- none. What could have carved that huge monument then? We say Atlantis. We say there was a civilisation on this planet 10,000 or so BC called Atlantis of which Plato speaks of in his book, *Timaeus*, and of whose existence Solon, the famous Athenian lawgiver was told of by an ancient Egyptian philosopher. Egypt was always to the Greeks the heart of the Ancient Wisdom Religion which is where they got their teachings from. Plato described it in his book and speaks of Atlantis in the Atlantic Ocean, and speaks of the great flood -- and of course we get religion after religion speaking of the great flood.

When you get the proofs of Hierarchy it is relatively simple to look at as you go back into time and you see such things as the great Sphinx and the Pyramids of Giza -- this huge monument erected out of stone transported hundreds of miles away. One block being about 200 tonnes in weight -- there are only two cranes on this entire earth today that can lift 200 tonnes! They would have to spend weeks of mathematical calculations figuring out how to do that. Yet here these ancients could lift that and place these huge megaton rocks high above the earth at precise alignment with the earth's north-south axis etc. Not only that but the blocks that housed the great Sphinx are also 200 tonnes in weight all perfectly aligned one on top of the other. This ancient civilisation had technology far in advance to present-day humanity. Where did it come from? What about all the mysteries of the great Sphinx and the great Pyramid? Not just the Egyptian pyramids but the Aztecs, the Mayans and the pre-Mayan pyramids, how were they built? Some of these were even larger than the great Pyramid and are all built around the same time. Where did the Mayans get their precise astrological calendar of which only modern science now can have the same precision? When

you are talking about procession of the equinoxes and so forth. When you add all the testimony of all the ancient monuments and ancient science together, you can say that this wisdom teaching has been on this earth since time immemorial and Enlightened Beings have been on this earth guiding humanity since time immemorial. Because truly we are talking of high culture and high science. This is what the Hierarchy is -- the most Enlightened of all Beings that Earth has ever produced from Atlantis onwards, incarnate again and again to put an adrenaline shot in the course of civilisation, to further the evolutionary growth of humanity, to push humanity onwards closer and closer to greater knowledge, to greater Love.

Last time we had on the whole this Hierarchy of Light incarnating was at the time of the Renaissance. All those great poets and artists that we know of and we gaze at in awe in our museums such as Leonardo da Vinci and Raphael and Michelangelo and Al Greco and all these types of beings. Then there is the Reformation itself with Martin Luther and myriads of Beings that incarnated more or less together to help bring civilisation out of the dark ages. These individuals that incarnated in order to give humanity the best of culture, the best of the new science, the new art styles and to make humanity think and begin to react against the papacy and the old religion of Roman Catholicism -- this is Hierarchy incarnating giving humanity its shining lights and not individuals that are suddenly geniuses beyond human imagination, such as a Shakespeare, a Francis Bacon or a Plato or a Archimedes or a Pythagoras or a Buddha or a Christ. This is all Hierarchy. These great beings have incarnated throughout time for the benefit of humanity.

It is logical that the human kingdom also has a hierarchical structure as does the body and the rest of nature. Common emotional humanity or common sex-based emotional humanity are beings that are just interested in sex and violence and all those types of martial types of things, they don't have much thinking process but are more reactive and use their primal urges to live their physical plane life. They are intensely selfish and intensely sexual and intensely argumentative and somewhat violent -- this is at the very bottom if you wish. Then you get the emotional humanity and they are the next rung up where they are more or less involved with their own material self and they are emotionally involved and watch television in their great masses. All the shows that are to do with emotional issues and common human relationships and they worship the movie stars and the rock stars and they spend virtually all their time and money in these emotional pursuits, sensual pleasures and material lifestyles. This is what rules our societies today; people's greed and peoples desire to have more and more money so they can get more and more pleasurable things. Common emotional humanity.

The next rung up is the Intelligentsia, the thinkers, our scientists and sometimes our politicians and lawyers, sometimes our artists and artisans. They think. They are not so much interested in material pleasure as such. There is not so much material indulgence and watching so many movies and sitcoms and shows about

common life experiences. What they are interested in is creativity, governments and helping humanity and sometimes selfishly so, they are interested in big business. They are the thinkers and out of them you get the next rung up; the philosophers. Those that are seriously working at helping humanity because they can see quite clearly that humanity are totally selfish and stealing from one another in order to build their own little empires of greed and lust and material comforts. This planet is doomed because this type of competitiveness means that there are some very selfish humans indeed in wealthy nations such as the United States and a lot of Europe, then there are exceedingly poor and the poverty stricken nations (mostly as a result of war) and these poor nations want their share of the planetary wealth. Not only that but eventually the planet destroys itself through destroying its resources. The rape of the planet and its rainforests, slaughter of animals in there billions, all for human greed and consumption.

So you get these philosophers trying to do something about that. The next pinnacle up from the intelligentsia -- those that can actually think very, very clearly about the true issues of the causes of suffering of human beings. When we get into this philosophical elite and they start to organise themselves, as they must as they are fighting common materialism and selfishness, then we get organisations such as Greenpeace and many of the religious fraternities that truly try to help human beings such as Mother Teresa in Calcutta who is offering homes for the homeless. You can multiply this type of thing in every society -- basically those that are working earnestly with very little money because they are fighting the way society is as a whole with their selfishness'. We would call these beings, Disciples, as far as Hierarchy goes. As we get higher with this pinnacle and there are beings that are starting to think lovingly about saving the planet and about inter-relating with each other lovingly, about the way they spend their time, not squandering it on material pleasures but creating instead whatever is beneficial to humanity, then we are starting to get closer to the apex of this pyramid that we are calling Hierarchy. These are disciples. Depending on their influence upon humanity and depending on how much they truly help humanity we are talking about high members of Hierarchy or younger members of Hierarchy incarnate. These are what we call degrees of initiation.

All members of Hierarchy therefore are working on the path of Love. They all sacrifice an aspect of themselves, their material indulgences, their material comforts, their selfishness, to work upon themselves in order to create a better picture for the world, a more true and harmonious world. They are more willing to chain themselves onto trees in front of excavation equipment because that may be the only way to get that forest saved. They are willing to endure a lot of hardships in order to save whales and fish and other creatures on this planet. This is the most elementary level of Hierarchy in the sense that the younger members of Hierarchy have a common vision of the greed and selfishness of multinational companies, for instance on this planet and that it must somehow be fought. That is if this planet is not to self-destruct because of a few greedy people

with billions of dollars and enormous amounts of waste around them in which they have built their billions of dollar's empires.

As you climb up the ladder of Hierarchy you go from this more common base of people that are exoterically in an outward fashion helping and doing much good for the planet -- though they are still very emotional or they still haven't properly thought out all the issues -- they don't yet understand the way that they manifest their lives can be somewhat in a greedy fashion too. They are still involved for example in material comforts, they are still largely thinking of themselves even though part of them is still focused on the planet and their issue, because it's usually only one issue that they are looking at. It can be a nuclear issue or a rainforest issue or whales, and as you become more awakened to the higher levels of Hierarchy you begin to think more of multi-issues and multidimensional thinking of the planet as a whole. You start getting away from the single issues and you are beginning to think more into the unification of issues and the unification of humanity. A wholeness, a synergy, a oneness. Not just materialistic thinking either but more in terms of religion, and not just in terms of one religion such as Buddhism but in terms of all religions. The higher you get in Hierarchy and Hierarchical thinking the more you think in terms of one. The more you think in terms of unity and the common good and a much more synthetic understanding. Some great politicians and leaders can be great members of Hierarchy trying to help the planet and they are fighting the entire society that they are a part of, and their own cabinets sometimes. They might not even get that far -- simply because they understand that to change the way people as a whole think is the way to save the planet. One way is to chain yourself to a tree but another way is to actually try and produce education for the planet to produce lots of information -- the more you can educate the planet on various issues, the better it is for changing the issues and saving things such as forests.

You can also get people that make movies about issues that are of great benefit to humanity. When you get those kinds of individuals that are working their lives in such a way so that they can influence larger and larger amounts of people and actually change public opinion, then you get the higher members of Hierarchy incarnate in that particular person -- you are getting closer to the pinnacle. As you get higher members of Hierarchy then you get those beings that are more often veiled. They are not so much in the public eye as there is so much to do because they are conquering glamour, conquering pride. When individuals put themselves in a position of leadership in such a way that is very showy, then you get the pride element. The higher members of Hierarchy don't have time for adoration of the masses. They don't have a lot of time for the answering of thousands of letters. On the whole they are too busy. They are freed from public adoration and all that type of activity that comes with it. They are not movie stars as such they are far more veiled. They could be the Buddhist monk sitting in a monastery, influencing thousands of people through more occult means -- telepathically for instance -- sending thought images to their disciples all over the world, and they are sitting in just one spot. Just like the great Buddhist masters

do such as Milarepa, Padmasambhava, Tsongkapa and some of the Zen monks of the past. They do not need to be outwardly running around in this world, they simply need to awaken their full powers and full awarenesses to influence many, giving them loving energy, beautiful visions and beautiful thoughts so that they go out and do the work that needs to be done. Now we are getting close to the pinnacle of Hierarchy.

The very highest members of Hierarchy are sent out from time to time such as Jesus or the Buddha or Tsongkapa to become major reformers. These beings, when they come out they start major religions. They start major reformations and they are very rarely respected for what they do. They have to fight every inch of the way against public opinion. Whenever Jesus walked around to teach very rarely did he have a lot of followers, people often picked up rocks to throw at him because he was teaching what the Jews thought were blasphemy. That was the crime that he committed to them -- sheer blasphemy. They did not understand what he gave them in his teachings of love at all. He evaded Judea most of the time and spent a lot of time in Galilee and other areas that was not so Jewish in those days because of fear of the Jews. His twelve warned him on what is called Palm Sunday, again and again you go there and you risk having your life taken. Once he even said to his twelve "will you leave me also?" Because all his other disciples had left him. And Peter said "where can we go? You are the embodiment of the truth, there is no other teacher." There was just twelve left, and even of those twelve, one eventually betrayed him and he was crucified. This is the highest members of Hierarchy incarnate thus, they become world saviours.

When these higher members of Hierarchy do incarnate they teach truths that for the customs of the time, for the way that people think, is not at all understood. It is like John the Baptist -- a voice crying in the wilderness -- "*repent ye*", he said, "*make your paths straight for the coming of the Lord.*" The Christians often say that was John's voice crying in the wilderness preparing people for the coming of Jesus. But this is the way the higher members of Hierarchy are -- they are often voices crying in the wilderness. Common religion - and even these new age religions are still common religions -- just a higher way of thinking -- but the higher initiated members of Hierarchy cannot give out common platitudes to feed the emotional masses. They've come now to destroy emotional thinking. They've come to teach the way of the intelligentsia for the world, the way of discipleship, the new teachings of Love -- what love is and what it is not. Most often always misunderstood, always have stones thrown -- and what are stones esoterically? Well spiritually speaking, they are thought forms, thought forms tied with emotions. People use these thought forms as their mouths and they scream at these individuals, they can cause malicious gossip, slander them, they will not allow the truth to come. These individuals are castigated in the public media if they come out to the surface with their teachings. Always opposition.

The Hierarchy is what is called in our philosophy, the Heart in the body of God -- the Heart centre. Looking at God -- the God of our planetary system, not

necessarily the God of this Universe but simply the God or the Logos of the planet -- as the Heart of this Planetary Regent. We call this the Hierarchy -- the Heart centre. The Kingdom of God we call Shamballa -- this is the Head or the thinking aspect of this planetary system. The members of Shamballa, or the Kingdom of God are simply the Hierarchy of a former planetary evolution that have come to this earth to help humanity. They are here to help bring about the whole appearance of the human kingdom out over the lesser kingdoms of nature. Humanity embodies the other chakras. The major chakras in the body of God -- the throat centre, the solar plexus, the sacral centre and the base of spine. The throat centre; the intelligentsia. The solar plexus centre; average human beings. The sacral centre; those sex oriented human beings whose prime focus is sex and sexual indulgence and martial arts, war types activities, the violent types, the unthinking types. The base of the spine really refers to the four lower kingdoms of nature. One petal of the four petals relates to the human kingdom, the other petal relates to the animal kingdom, the other petal relates to the plant kingdom and the final petal relates to the mineral kingdom. Four petals -- four kingdoms. These are the major chakras in the body of God. The minor chakras relate to the various categories of the animal kingdom and then the smaller chakras relate to the various categories of the plant kingdom and very tiny points of light which are the acupuncture points they all relate to the categories of the mineral kingdom. All the chakras are just doorways of expression to the various kingdoms of nature through which the human being has evolved. We have evolved from the mineral to the plants, plants to the animal, animal to human kingdom. From the human we can go into the superhuman states. And all that Hierarchy are, are members of the human kingdom that have evolved out of the human kingdom in a sense and have awakened to superhuman states of consciousness. They are in between becoming a Kingdom of God and thus leaving this planet altogether as Buddha.

A Buddha is simply a member of Hierarchy, a member of humanity that has gone on through the entire gamut of Hierarchy to become a Christ and as a consequence of that person's evolution and attainment -- they have evolved so far and so fast, away from human thinking and human consciousness that the state of awareness that that Being has is so transcendent that they can no longer properly help human beings. Thus a Buddha is one who has worked and cleansed all Karma with human beings and all the kingdoms of nature, and now after that last act of service for human beings by giving to his disciples the teachings and the energies needed (the new world religion if you wish) goes off into cosmic space as a young child in the stars and goes to learn the language, the law, the teaching, the way of living of beings in cosmic space. He goes off to another star system as a child because all that such a Being has really done is been born out of the womb of the great Mother of this earth. All members of Hierarchy are evolving to become Buddhas. Eventually all humanity should become Buddha. In the Bible it simply says "the Christ will renew the hope, the glory" and Jesus himself said when he was overshadowed by the Christ "as I have sent to the father and into the kingdom of God I must take all men unto me,"

I will be with you always until the end of the ages is what he is saying -- meaning they will always be helping humanity -- always incarnate for the benefit of humanity until all of humanity have become Buddhas and humanity is ready to build their spaceships -- their ships of light and love -- and leave this planet altogether. They leave it in consciousness, they leave it as chakras, and they leave it as members of Hierarchy.

And likewise when Jesus talked to his followers and they asked him why he spoke in parables -- he said I speak in parables because these individuals (in other words, humanity and common religions) of this time, "*having ears, hear not, having eyes see not*", and neither do they understand -- therefore I have to speak to them in this simple terminology, in parables. But when speaking to his twelve he said, you can be given the mysteries of the Kingdom of God -- to you I can speak openly because *you are not of this world as I am not of this world*. This is the way Hierarchy is. For Hierarchy, their method of achieving Hierarchical consciousness is what is called Initiation into the mysteries of the Kingdom of God. Of which technically there are nine Initiations and each of these Initiation steps are steps that awaken you more and more as to these mysteries, more and more of the understanding of what cosmic space is and of the way of evolution of the stars themselves. Of where we've come from as human beings from our monad or spirit selves incarnating into souls and evolving as souls through myriads of incarnations, gaining much wisdom and experience on this physical plane. And eventually the soul itself dying at the fourth initiation, which is what Jesus undertook when he died on the cross he said "*my God, why hast thou forsaken me?*" That particular time in the fourth initiation, the soul itself dies and for one brief moment the initiate knows what it is like to stand at the very beginning of time before there was God, before there was light, before there was anything. Then the initiate grows and the experience of cosmic evolution onwards and onwards until he sees the far vast future time space continuum and the way that whole star systems evolve and the entire purpose of the cosmos.

That cosmic visioning, the way of the evolution of the spirit or monad as we call it is what was accorded to Jesus on the cross. The symbolism of the destruction of the soul and the veil of it is given in the Bible, "*the veil of the temple was rent in twain*". The temple is the temple of the soul. Its veil is its form destroyed. So it means technically the ending of incarnations for such a being. No more does he need to incarnate and that this particular initiation which is the entire purpose of Buddhist philosophy to attain the sunyata experience which they can't explain in terms of words they just simply say what it is not, this nirvana or moksha. It is impossible to explain to people who have minds full of emotions, what a state of being beyond the mind is -- beyond the soul is. It simply is "being" they call it. Being-ness -- neither this nor that. That which is in between all things. So all of Buddhism is trying to get people 'beings' to become as Jesus did on the cross. And this is the way of Hierarchy. This is the transcendence of the Buddha.

Evolution does not stop. It does not stop for any God, it does not stop for any

human being, it does not stop for any termite on this planet and it does not stop for any mineral unit. Everything is always evolving because we are imperfect, so God is imperfect. God is just simply a great Buddha being that for the sake of helping out all sentient beings has limited his consciousness or her consciousness in time and space to help a planet such as this earth onwards, and will stand by that planet. Seeding that planet with a consciousness, with love and light through all the stages of evolutionary process until the entire human kingdom evolves and becomes Buddhas and Gods in their turn. When a Buddha goes off into cosmic space all a Buddha is really learning to do is to become a Planetary Deity and later on a Solar Deity and further on a Cosmic Deity. Always evolving, always expanding, everything is relative. You are God to the cells in your body -- you can destroy those cells as you wish, you can poison your body, you can cut out a part of your body and kill all the cells there, or you could try and keep your body very, very healthy indeed. You can keep your brain cells healthy indeed so you can think. Likewise in the body of God we are just simply cells therein all of the human souls. And the cells as I said, are organised in a hierarchical structure this is what hierarchy is and how hierarchy is. Each little cell eventually evolving to become an organelle and each organelle then evolving to become something like a heart -- and that's what a great Enlightened Being is. For humanity, they represent the collective consciousness of the great organ in the body of God such as the heart, lungs, liver etc but they are the chakras thereof, not so much the forms, but they also can manifest as the forms.

Each great member of Hierarchy which we call the Chohans of the Rays distribute the seven Rays of light -- not the colours of light known to the physical sciences but the esoteric colours.

The First Ray: Will or Power.
Second Ray: Love - Wisdom,
Third ray: Active Intelligence,
Fourth Ray: Harmony through Conflict,
Fifth Ray: Scientific Endeavour,
Sixth Ray: Devotion,
Seventh Ray: Ceremonial Magic.

These Rays all have musical notes associated with them and when they interrelate we get Sub-Rays. And so they interrelate more and more and we get all the gradations and appearance of phenomena. All the categories of life, because what we are talking about is energy and its interrelationship as conditioned by consciousness as conditioned by mind. The great Beings in Hierarchy, these Seven Ray Chohans are responsible for the Seven major Divisions, the Seven major Chakras on this planet and the way energies interrelate. Energy and mass are interrelated. Energy equals mass times the speed of light squared. One of the great formulations of science. Of course, Einstein was a great member of Hierarchy to give us that -- that's what he incarnated for. He was there to push on science enormously.
